Romanian and Slovakian Bibles to distribute in Romania a few years ago, and whom Josh and I met in person for the first time in May as he planned to return to Romania to do more ministry over the second half of this year.

With great surprise, I was shocked to hear the news from Arthur's pastor, that whilst in Athens, en route to Romania with his wife, Arthur succumbed to illness and sadly passed away.
