Whilst that is just a quick outline of my 'last' times here in Timisoara, I am thankful for the time I have been able to spend with those here and being able to say goodbye and finish up my time here 'well'.

Come this Friday another adventure, or should I say marathon, will begin. You can follow this on the 'upcoming events' list, but I wanted to let you know a bit more.

<u>Germany</u>- 8 adults from Potter's House will be taking 10 children to Nuremberg for ten days. We will be driving across (about twelve hours) and staying in a farmhouse and barn during our stay, but going out and doing programs with the children at a number of different places. Whilst partly to create awareness for *Casa Olarului*, we pray that hearts would also be opened to receive the Good News.

<u>Serbia</u>- This will be my third camp in Serbia. It is going to be a packed program and I believe also a full camp (as two camps were joined into one). Please pray for those who are new and those who are returning, that hearts would be changed and revived!

<u>English Family Camp</u>- My main role will be looking after one of the organiser's two month old baby, and where possible, helping out with other activities. Please pray as people learn English, that they would take away a lot more and that the Lord's love would dwell in their hearts.

<u>IT Retreat</u>- Our last thing together, my team will be going on a retreat for four days to spend time together before we go our separate ways. We know God has His reasons for all the changes going on, but on a good note, it is exciting that Jen and Adi will also be studying at SMBC and that Jen will even be in my class, so it's not all over yet.

I will have a week back in Timisoara before I finally leave Romania on 9th August to travel for a while before returning mid-late September. This in mind, I hope I will be able to write another newsletter in that week.

Thank you again for your continued love, prayers and support over these last two years. And whilst I soon will be missing Romania, I look forward to rekindling my relationships back in Australia as the next season of my life begins.
