On Sat 4th May, I had the privilege of spending the day on a refugee camp with eight families from such countries as Iraq, Egypt and Palestine. I am currently preparing to head to Vâlcea in August where I hope to begin establishing relationships with Mike and Elvira and the others I will be working alongside. I will be stopping over in Timişoara, where I previously lived (2008-2010) to visit friends, before heading to Râmnicu Vâlcea where I will be joining in on one of the Rroma (Gypsy) camps, before going to Germany for an I.Teams Europe Conference. I hope to have more of an idea about exact budgets etc. when I return, though I have begun to raise my support, knowing I am a long way off from being able to move there long-term. Please join me in praying for God to raise up those to financially partner with me in the journey ahead, whether it be as little as \$50 per month, every amount will get me closer the 90% of pledged funds I need to be able to book my tickets.

I also invite you to let me know if your church, Bible Study group or women's group etc. would be interested in having me share about this journey. I know it is not only my life that is impacted by what He is doing, but I pray you too would be encouraged, as you serve Him in whatever direction He sends you.

I am excited to watch God bring about His plans once more and to compose His score for my life. He certainly hasn't stopped entertaining me with His sense of humour and creativity yet. Dare I say, watch this space!
