experience has greatly complimented the theory of uni, and my skills in design, administration, and logistics have grown greatly during these last two and a half years. Now the time has come to change gears as we are able to concentrate more fully on preparation, in all of its facets.

As our departure looms closer, Manda's first aid certificate was due for renewal. We both took the opportunity to attend a day of 'Provide First Aid' training with St John's Ambulance. These skills will be useful as we travel with a young child who is increasingly investigating everything around her. There will also be times that we are in unfamiliar surroundings as we travel to different workers across the country, without knowing immediately where suitable facilities may be. As good an idea as it is to be prepared in this way, please continue to uphold our health and safety in prayer as God carries us as we go. We cannot do this in our own strength, nor do we want to.

Multicultural Blessings...

Two years ago I (Manda) became connected with a man who was preparing to go to Romania to hand out Bibles to Romanian and Slovakian communities, amongst other things. It was a privilege at the time to help put him in contact with workers in Romania who were able to source Bibles in these languages to hand out. So, when Arthur called me up again a few weeks ago and told me he was preparing to go to Romania for another five months and was looking for more Bibles to distribute, I started the process of sourcing more resources for him through the RWN. Please pray with us that more Bibles and resources will become available for this, and for other workers also.

In my conversation with Arthur I asked whether there might be opportunity to share at his church, only to find out that his church, Bankstown Community Church, was pastored by my Travel agent and his family, and the cousin of a longtime friend of Josh. So our opportunity to share with Arthur and this 'new' church turned out to be a bit of a reunion and a real joy as we worshipped together and enjoyed some yummy Lebanese food together for their Mother's day celebration. This was certainly another reminder that God has His perfect timing, and that our 'random' connections with people are anything but just that.

As we seek to raise the final 15% that we need to book our flights, do you know of any further contacts for us to share with? We are able to share with churches or small groups or even if you would like to have a conversation over a cuppa with us. We love being able to share the vision God has given us for the Rroma people and all that God is doing in Romania among the workers, but of course we long to get there as soon as we can and covet your prayers for this to be possible soon.

Please pray that God will provide the remaining 15% of our needs soon. In a practical sense, that is about 1 person @ \$200/mth, 4 people @ \$100/mth, 4 people @ \$50/mth, and 4 people @ \$25/mth. Will you partner with us and help us get back to Romania?

Once we get there...

As well as getting settled into everyday life as a family in Ramnicu Valcea and all that comes with that, requests are already being made by workers for us to go and visit them and their ministries. We would appreciate your prayers for wisdom as we make plans regarding the Rroma-Workers Network and all the needs that are beckoning. With 150+ workers across the country, the needs are great, so we would appreciate your prayers as we balance our family's needs and the demands of ministry so that we can thrive in the task God has called us to.

Over the past few weeks I've now been able to register our family to attend both the International Teams Europe Conference in Germany in August, and the 3rd European Roma Conference in Bosnia and Herzegovina in October. God is certainly at work in Romania and indeed around Europe, and we are excited to be part of God's bigger picture, knowing that He has plans for us even now, but certainly when we get there. Please pray with us for the Rroma people to come to know Christ, and that God will continue to bring revival through His people, for His glory alone!
